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Internal Smart India Hackathon, SIH-2023 in Gyan Ganga College of Technology, Jabalpur on 23[™] Sep 2023

Our Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, visualizes a digital India to bridge the digital divide in our country and further promote digital literacy. In order to work towards our PM's vision, the MoE Innovation Cell, the Group of Twenty (G20), the Govt. Of India, the All-India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), the Inter Institutional Inclusive Innovation Center (i4C), and Persistent Systems have jointly decided to organize the Smart India Hackathon 2023 for engineering students.

The Smart India Hackathon is a nationwide initiative to provide students with a platform to solve some of the pressing problems we face in our daily lives and thus inculcate a culture of product innovation and a mindset of problem-solving. The first five editions SIH2017, SIH2018, SIH2019, SIH2020, and SIH2022 proved to be extremely successful in promoting innovation and out-of-the-box thinking in young minds, especially engineering students from across India.

To keep this in mind, Gyan Ganga College of Technology has conducted an internal Smart India hackathon in which more than 60 teams presented their ideas under different themes like smart vehicles, smart automation, smart education, disaster management, robotics and drones, blockchain & cyber security, agriculture, food technology, rural development, renewable energy, fintech, games and toys, heritage and culture, tourism, health technology, transportation and logistics, and miscellaneous.

Front-End Development Workshop
